## Template dos and don'ts:

First and foremost, it is a celebratory and welcoming environment for all (LGBTQI+ and straight audiences) at the events.

Ideally, inform the attendees about the events involving full nudity, scenes of explicit sexual nature or parental guidance requirements, as applicable.

If applicable, please stipulate an age restriction entry due to licensing requirements (say, for 18+ films, etc.).

Make sure you have acquired: required licences where needed, permissions for the events and confirmation of participation in advance before publicising the events. Do consider working in partnerships with local groups, businesses and statutory bodies to ensure the success of the
