We asked Maternity Worldwide's team of midwives at the Pirimiti Community Hospital in Zomba, Malawi what they would most want as a Christmas gift this year:

"... an incubator. With the recent high rate of premature babies in our Malawi hospitals I have experienced that the incubators are not enough to accommodate the number of babies born premature in our hospitals. We have to combine the babies in one incubator whereby making them to be exposed to communicable diseases. It's a pity sometimes when you get to the hospital and see how congested the incubator room is."
