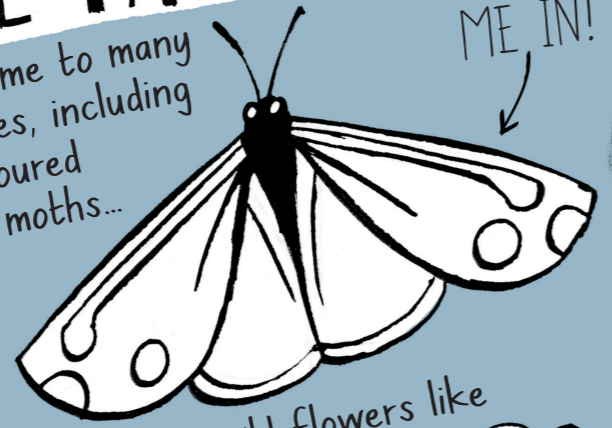


ON THE FARM

The GOG is home to many unusual species, including brightly coloured Cinnabar moths...

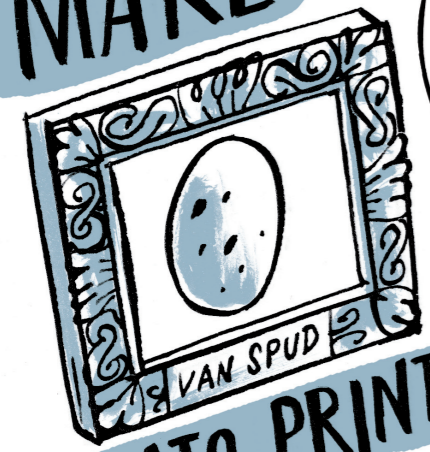


COLOUR ME IN!

THE EYES REALLY FOLLOW YOU ROUND THE ROOM!



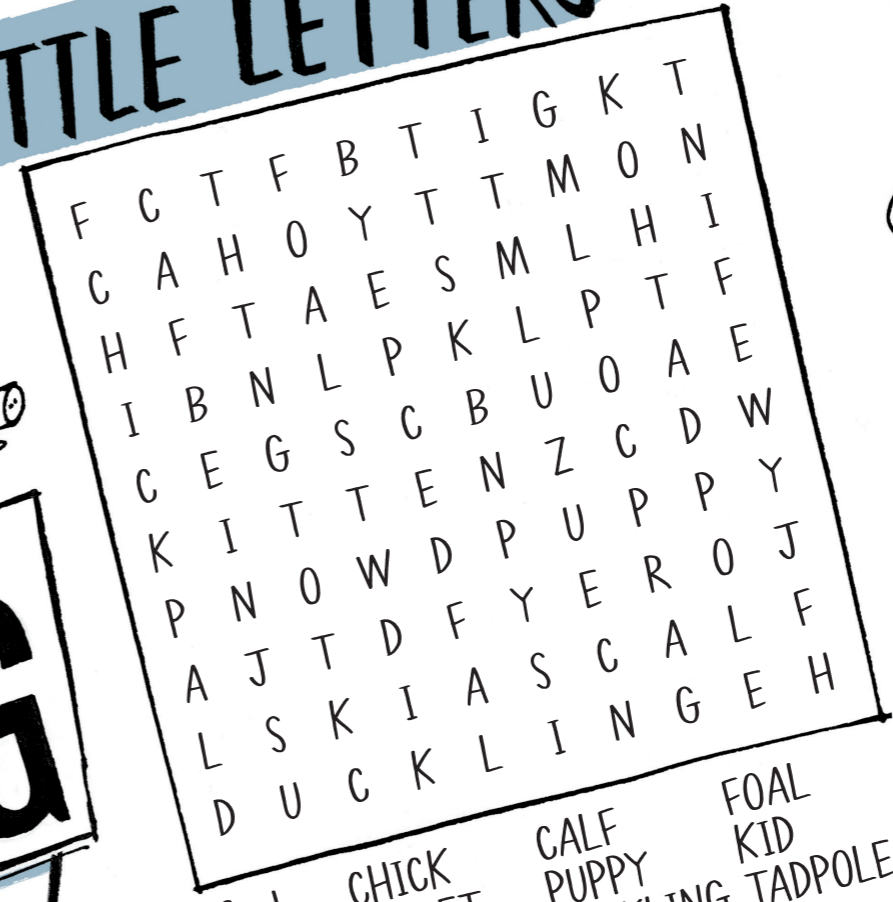
CRAZY MAZERY
