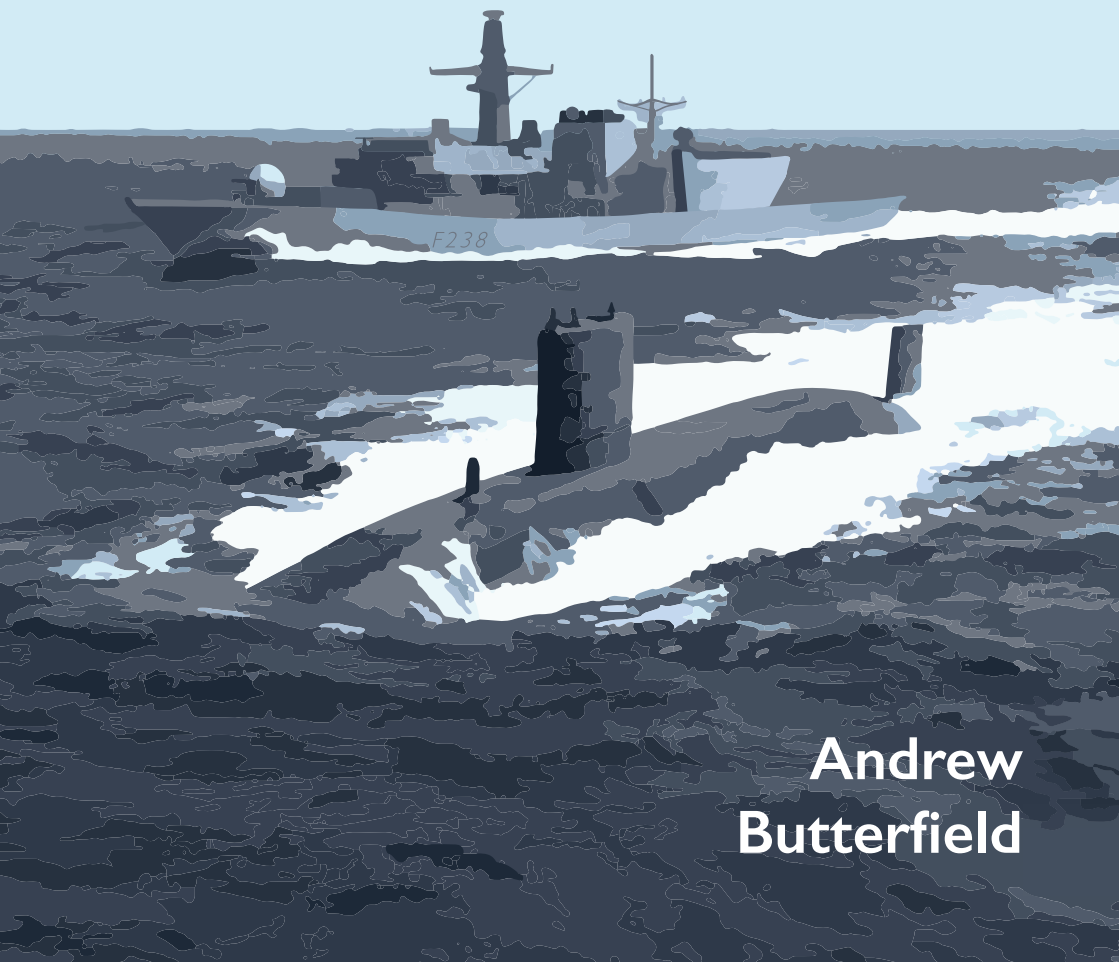


A SUBMARINER'S TALE
