

DONATE adds recurring donation functionality

17th October 2016 - DONATE the UK's mobile-first donation platform, today announces a relaunched product. Key to the relaunch is a facility to turn donor donations into monthly recurring donations - be that through text or mobile-web. Other major developments include an improved donation flow enabling donors to give as guests, text-registration for auction bidding and improved search and discovery features.

Philippa Esson, Development & Communications Director of DONATE, said: "All improvements in this latest release are the result of requests from our user base. Charities were keen for their donors to be able to turn a one-off donation into a regular monthly gift and for the donation flow to be further refined. The ongoing growth we have seen in DONATE is driven by responding to our users' requests."

About the National Funding Scheme

The National Funding Scheme, operating under the DONATE brand, provides a range of free mobile fundraising tools for charitable organisations to maximise fundraising campaigns.

Charities pay 2.5% of the donation to cover payment processing. When donors add Gift Aid DONATE sends on 114% of the donation.
