- Unique, highly precise 3D ruler for scaling and measuring models
- Overhang shader to highlight areas that need support
- Basic online modeller for beginners learning the ropes
- Export to third-party services, such as 3DHubs, Shapeways and i.materialise

Along with these online tools, the development team at 3DShook also targets professional users with its recently released **Autodesk Maya plugin**, the 3DShook Printing Exporter, which allows Maya users to scale, place and position models within Maya, get print quotes from external services and print items using our tools. The plugin is available at no cost from the <u>Autodesk App Store</u>.

'The 3D Printing Exporter lets you select a grid and scale for the object, quickly autocenter to plate and export your objects as OBJs in a ZIP file with the push of a button'. –source Lesterbanks

The plugin supports over 50 printer bed grids and offers Maya users instant access to all of 3DShook's online printing tools.

'Some of us at 3DShook are veteran Maya users, so it only seemed natural to develop the plugin for Maya first. We are working on adapting it to other platforms'. –**Nadav Brill, 3DShook CTO**


