- You are no longer learning new things – the happiest workers are those who are stimulated and constantly learning and overcoming challenges. Creative types are the personalities that require this the most.
- You are underperforming –stagnated workers who could do their job whilst asleep, are probably underperforming. A job that challenges and stimulates the mind will result in a person working at their highest level.
- You feel undervalued – even when workers are happy with their earnings, they will not enjoy work unless they feel appreciated; especially by their managers.
- You are just doing it for the money – staying in an unhappy work environment just for the money is unrewarding and demotivating. Intrinsic rewards influence workers engagement much more than extrinsic rewards.
- You hate your boss – research has shown that 75% of working adults find that the most stressful part of their job is their immediate supervisor or direct line manager. Companies need to be better at selecting and developing leaders.
