David began by offering his special thanks to their most honoured guest, **The Rt Hon Theresa May MP** for her much appreciated attendance and, as David said, during his brief speech, "Hopefully, Theresa will be our next Prime Minister". He then went on to thank Councillor Simon Dudley (RBWM Lead), Cllr David Coppinger and Cllr Samantha Rayner, for their attendance and much valued support. Finally, David thanked the Charity's Patron, Sue Holderness, for her continued and valuable enthusiasm in support of '**ADS**'.

In his brief speech, David said, "Today we are here to celebrate the official opening of our new '**ADS**' **Charity Shop** as well as to celebrate 5 years of **ADS**'s work in support of the People living with Dementia, their Carers and Families within our **Local** Community and he quipped "doesn't time fly?" He also offered his heartfelt thanks, on behalf of the hard-working and dedicated '**ADS**' team, to everyone who had supported the Charity during its first 5-years and explained, "Without the support of their many Volunteers, Donors, Customers, Staff, Partner Agencies, the RBWM etc., the Charity would not be where it is today – supporting approximately 900 local people, living with the disease". He went on to explain; "your assistance, over the years, in support of '**ADS**' members had been totally invaluable".

Thereafter, he invited The Rt. Hon Theresa May MP to speak after which, he thanked her for her very kind words. He also thanked her and her husband, (Philip), for their on-going interest and support of our '**ADS**' activities.

Finally, David asked Theresa to 'cut the ribbon' and declare the new '**ADS**' **Charity Shop** officially open. Once the formal ceremony was complete, Theresa, followed by a huge crowd, entered the shop.

David later said; "Theresa remained with us for a long time as she was not surprisingly 'centre of attention' for many who jostled to personally speak to her – each wanting to offer their own words of support to Theresa. Despite all the activity surrounding her, Theresa remained relaxed and very friendly as she patiently posed for an exhaustive number of 'selfies' and photo's".

Following Theresa's departure, the tills at the new '**ADS**' **Charity shop** began ringing as shopper's picked-up bargains!

David closed by stating that after the day, he hoped locals in the community would continue to support '**ADS**' for the next 5-years and beyond.
