

AstraZeneca/Oxford vaccine - high street pharmacies are ideally based placed to deliver the AZ/Oxford vaccine

Following yesterday's test results by the Oxford study that transmission is reduced by 67% with the AstraZeneca/Oxford vaccine, the Association Of Independent Multiples (AIMp) the organisation representing high street pharmacies, is calling to accelerate the deployment of The AstraZeneca/Oxford vaccine across high street pharmacies to accelerate the vaccination programme.

AIMp CEO Dr Leyla Hannbeck said:

We believe that the Government must align vaccination centres to focus upon the cohorts and booster doses, utilising high street pharmacies to offer the first dose of AstraZeneca/Oxford vaccine. By using high street pharmacies in this way, we can support this effort to drastically reduce transmission and even the likelihood of infection."
