Residents at Miners Court in Redruth were given the chance to meet a selection of robotic creatures as part of an EPIC Tech event hosted at the Coastline Housing scheme.

Therapeutic pets including an animatronic seal, dinosaur and puppy joined forces with Pepper the robot to socialise with residents and even lead them in a dance fitness routine.

Donna Pollard, Registered Manager at Miners Court, said: "Everyone thought the therapeutic pets were just amazing and the residents really loved holding them and interacting with them.
