

Best-Selling Author Crowned Local Hero 2019 Champion

- Local Hero 2019 champion, Ben Kane, raises £10k for Park in the Past CIC and gains a top prize of £1,000
- Over £160k raised for local charities and community groups across the UK through Local Hero 2019
- 453 fundraisers representing 209 local charities and community groups took part
- £5000 in prizes distributed to the groups represented by the top-20 fundraisers

453 fundraisers have raised over £160,000 for 209 local charities and community groups from across the UK through Localgiving's annual fundraiser competition Local Hero.

This year's competition was won by the Sunday Times Best-Selling author, [Ben Kane](#). Ben, a specialist in historical-fiction, used the competition to bring his passion for the Roman Empire to life.

Ben Kane walked the length of Hadrian's wall in full centurion attire, accompanied by his 12 year old son. The author secured an incredible 218 unique donations for his walk, raising over £10k including £1000 in prize money for [Park in the Past CIC](#).

Each year [Local Hero](#) highlights the huge difference that individual fundraisers can make. During the competition fundraisers set challenges ranging from Marathon running to sky-diving, and compete to top the Local Hero leaderboard and secure prize money for their chosen charity or community group.

Overall £5,000 in prizes have been awarded to the causes supported by the Top 20 fundraisers.
