The Amateur Jockey License option would involve the same intensive training Victoria Pendleton received at the beginning of her Switching Saddles journey.

The Raceday will also include a charity lunch and auction to raise funds for Racing Welfare. It will be held in Doncaster's superb Mallard Restaurant, with a champagne reception (kindly sponsored by Pommery), an excellent 3-course lunch and an exciting auction.
