Browsing with Tor doesn't require waiting for a Kickstarter project

Toronto, ON -- 11/25/2014 -- In recent months there have been a number of crowd-funding campaigns to raise money for research into developing a product to allow people to surf the net in private, however, that product is already available thanks to Ninjastik. The people at NinjaStik have released a new line of online privacy products that automatically let users browse online with Tor anonymity.

Responding to consumer demand for a lower cost, ready-to-use online privacy device, this month sees the release of NinjaStik Lite - a high speed USB 2.0 drive with all browsing automatically routed through Tor and a fully encrypted desktop environment. The NinjaStik Lite is following on more than 2 years of successful sales of the original NinjaStik which also features the convenience of Tor browsing automatically configured on a USB 3.0 flash drive.

The NinjaStiks hide the users IP address and provide a secure computing environment that leaves no trace of their activity on the computer. All activity and data, files, pictures, even bookmarks are secured with 256 bit encryption automatically.

All NinjaStiks are designed from the ground up to be intuitive and convenient, the user simply plugs the NinjaStik into an USB port and boots the computer from the USB. The NinjaStik is entirely self-contained - the operating system, built on Lubuntu Linux, is secured with 256 bit encryption as are all files, data and activity. It features a user-friendly desktop, all of the latest drivers and will run on most Intel based computers including Mac and PC, 32 and 64 bit processors.

Computer users using the NinjaStik will be online with Tor in less than a minute. From a powered off computer to an open browser with Tor connection confirmed in 60 seconds. Even on older computers and netbooks, the NinjaStik is fast, responsive and easy to use.

All NinjaStiks automatically check for any updates to the Tor software. It also checks the entire operating system providing an alert when updates are required. The user only needs to enter their password and make a few clicks to ensure the system is completely up to date. All updates are also downloaded through the secure Tor environment.

Professional, positive customer service is vital to any consumer product. NinjaStik provides helpful assistance with any customer difficulties and backs every NinjaStik with a money back satisfaction guarantee.
