Channel 5 are proudly joining in World CSI Day, a global attempt to break the Guinness World Records® title for world's largest TV drama simulcast.

The CSI episode being shown at midnight on the 4th March 2015 on 5USA is *CSI: Crime Scene Investigation* S14 Episode#1421 titled 'Kitty'. This episode, which served as the pilot for *CSI: Cyber* will be shown simultaneously in more than 150 countries.

The event will celebrate 15 years of the CSI franchise, one of the biggest and most successful in the world and the U.S. premiere of *CSI: Cyber*. *CSI: Cyber*, starring Academy Award® Winner Patricia Arquette, is the next generation and fourth series in the CSI franchise.

The current record for the largest TV drama simulcast was achieved by the special 50th anniversary episode of *Doctor Who*, which was broadcast in 98 countries across six continents in November 2013.
