

Charity saw significant increase in eCard platform use on Mother's Day

A small poverty alleviation charity, Hope Spring Water experienced more than four fold increase in it's <u>Mother's Day ecard</u> sales, on mothering Sunday, 22nd March 2020. The organisation developed an in-house eCard platform three years ago. Supporters and visitors to the ecard site can send a Mother's Day ecard to their loved one, and make a donation to the charity.
