With many UK citizens currently earning below living wage these tax credits have in many ways become a vital lifeline, helping people stay above the poverty line. As well as being claimed by 40% of working families, entrepreneurs have also come to rely on tax credits, which are currently payable to anyone earning less than £14,000 a year. When starting a business - especially in a rural area where job opportunities are scarce and low in pay - entrepreneurs often turn to tax credits to ensure they have a steady income until the point of which their business is established and profitable. Jeremy Corbyn recently argued that by cutting tax credits, many budding entrepreneurs may be deterred from starting a business due to financial worries and not having the means to support themselves when starting out on their entrepreneurial journey. The conservative government believe that a cut to tax credits would in the long run save the economy money, as since 1999 spending on tax credits has almost trebled.
