Bringing with them some of their favourite dishes, like the extremely popular Cobb Salad, Bigoli Cacio e Pepe, and wafer-thin Chicken Paillard, along with their unmistakable branding and design features. Maintaining their light and airy 'yacht' feel, Chuc's have continued to make the detailing continuous throughout their restaurants. An ever-changing wine list will be the perfect accompaniment to this menu, focusing on seasonal old world and new world offerings. Diners can also choose from a takeaway menu, allowing them to enjoy their delicious food in the surrounding Kensington Gardens.
