

City investment managers celebrate 10 years of support for small African charity

The pioneering London-based systematic investment management firm, Aspect Capital, is this month marking 10 years of supporting primary education in Kenya with another donation to the school-development charity African Promise.

The company has been generously supporting African Promise since 2009 and has made annual donations over the past 10 years, which have helped the charity to upgrade and establish long-term programmes of support with seven partner primary schools in a rural corner of Kenya, benefiting more than 7,000 disadvantaged young children.

Aspect Capital is committed to playing an active part in the wider community and every year supports a wide range of local, national and international charities, as explained by Charity Committee member, Nicola Dale:

“The ability to ‘make a difference’ is of great importance to the entire company. We are all actively encouraged to participate in fundraising activities and to give our time to charitable causes, and each year, as a business, we allocate a certain amount of our annual pre-tax profits to a range of charitable contributions.”

In 2017 the charity was also voted by employees as the company’s annual Charity of the Year. This saw many of the firms’ 120 London-based staff participate in an indoor ultra-ironman style challenge which raised over £20,000, every penny of which was matched by the company.

Reflecting on the charity’s 10-year partnership with Aspect, which began with an out-of-the-blue invitation to present to the Charity Committee, Charles Coldman, founder and CEO of African Promise, says:
