Cultural Landscapes of Serbia – itinerary highlights:

BELGRADE - Includes: Kalemegdan, the city fortress; Rakija Bar; the old quarter; the Old Palace; St. Sava Cathedral.

VOJVODINA - Includes: Fruska Gora National Park, renowned for its vineyards and monasteries dating from the 15th and 16th centuries; Sremski Karlovci, a small baroque town famous for its architecture and wine cellars; Novi Sad, Serbia's second largest city.

KLADOVO - Includes: Viminacium, one of the most important Roman cities from the 1st to 4th centuries; Lepesni Vir – an important Mesolithic archaeological site dating from between 6700-5500 BC; Diana Roman fortification from the 2nd century AD.

VRNJACKA BANJA - Includes: Gamzigrad and Felix Romuliana with its beautiful frescoes and mosaic floors, a UNESCO-protected site and one of the finest examples of Roman palace architecture; Vrnjacka Banja, one of Serbia's most celebrated and beautiful spa towns.

STUDENICA - Includes: Studenica Monastery with its white marble churches housing an impressive collection of Byzantine-style frescoes; Sopocani Monastery, a UNESCO-protected site famed for its colourful wall paintings.

SARGAN EIGHT RAILWAY - Includes: an excursion to Sirogojno village famed for its traditional, hand made knitwear; Mokra Gora for a train journey on the Sargan Eight, a narrow-gauge railway; the ethnic village of Drvengrad.

ZLATIBOR TO BELGRADE - Includes: the small town of Topola to visit the stunning Byzantine-style church.
