The site had its soft launch in July and has already attracted the support of some strong ethical brands which have signed up for profiles including: **Friends of the Earth, Natural Power, Greenpeace, Good Energy, The Soil Association and Triodos Bank.** The diverse nature of these clients, from environmental campaigning organisations and charities, to tech for good companies tackling issues with food waste and sustainable food production demonstrates the breadth of opportunities now available for purpose-driven candidates.

Ethical Jobseeker doesn't plan to stop at championing the impact of others, it has serious ambitions to be a force for good in the recruitment industry. With clear plans to reinvest part of its profits into community and charitable projects, including its dedicated Corporate Grove run by Trees For Life, with pledges to plant one new tree for every job post and ten trees for every profile purchased, the company intends to practice what is preaches.
