A North East eatery is extending its opening hours next week to cater for thousands of concert goers.

National Glass Centre Brasserie, operated by 1879 Events Management, will be staying open until 9pm on Tuesday May 27 and Wednesday May 28 to coincide with One Direction's sell out appearance at the Stadium of Light.

The venue, which is just a short walk from the stadium, inside the recently refurbished National Glass Centre, Sunderland, will be serving its new Spring Menu on both evenings.
