Jump24 has launched the free to use **Awe-der** (<https://awe-der.net>) platform to help restaurants, pubs and cafes quickly move to an online ordering model.


In development over the past three weeks, Awe-der enables a business to instantly setup an online order page, create menus and start accepting online orders from their customers for collection or delivery.
