

GvHD Hub | Quarter Three 2020 Update

Work continued at a pace during the third quarter of 2020. The new website for the [GvHD Hub](#) was launched to great success in July and has seen a rise in readership. A new [editorial theme](#) exploring considerations for allogeneic hematopoietic stem cell transplantation from mismatched unrelated donors was selected mid-July.

A well-attended meeting with the [Steering Committee](#) was held for the first time virtually in July. These key opinion leaders in the field of GvHD commended the GvHD Hub on continuing to provide up-to-date, highly technical information to healthcare professionals during the global pandemic. The GvHD Hub [podcast channel](#) was introduced to great approval and plans for future content for the hub were discussed. The role of endothelial cells in GvHD, sequencing of anti-GvHD therapies, impact of novel agents on GvHD, and pathophysiology of GvHD with a focus on microbiota were chosen as key topics.

In late August and early September, the GvHD Hub covered the [Virtual 46th Annual Meeting of the European Society for Blood and Marrow Transplantation \(EBMT\)](#) on [Twitter](#). Interviews with key experts in the field were also performed along with the publication of concise summaries of important sessions.
