The procedure is fairly routine, but your scalp will feel tender for some days after the operation and you will need to take pain medications and sometimes anti-inflammatory drugs as well. After a few days, you should be able to go back to your normal everyday routine.

The transplanted hair will fall out after two or three weeks, but new hair should start appearing in the area after a couple of months. In some cases, growth enhancing medications will also be prescribed to improve the results.

If you made up your mind about going through with a hair transplant procedure, Turkey may be one of the best choices. The country really takes this new industry seriously, to the point where even government subsidies hair transplant clinics in different ways to help them succeed.
