

Illustrated World Series receives lifeline grant from Government's £1.57 billion Culture Recovery Fund

The [Illustrated World Series](#) has been awarded **£70,000** as part of the Government's £1.57 billion Culture Recovery Fund (CRF) to help face the challenges of the coronavirus pandemic and to ensure they have a sustainable future, the Culture Secretary has announced today.

The **Illustrated World Series** is one of 588 cultural and creative organisations across the country receiving urgently needed support – with £76 million of investment announced today. This follows £257 million awarded earlier in the week to 1,385 organisations, also from the Culture Recovery Fund grants programme being administered by Arts Council England on behalf of the Department for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport. Further rounds of funding in the cultural and heritage sector are due to be announced over the coming weeks.

Founded in 2010 the Illustrated World Series (IWS) offers an exciting tournament platform where artists battle head-to-head in 60-minute bouts to complete an A2 illustration inspired by a recent news headline. Showcasing some of the world's most talented emerging illustrators and street artists, watch as they compete live, witness a clash of styles and interpretations as they battle to become world No.1!

Technical ability doesn't always matter, more the ability to communicate an instantly thought provoking narrative, whether it be funny, serious or provocative – this underpins the series and drives the creation of such visceral, exciting and edgy content.

The IWS believe it's important for live illustration to have a solid and respected platform with a competitive and sporting ethos. As a developing and rapidly growing part of England's cultural ecology, IWS tournaments are popular with both professional and amateur artists and provide an essential, trusted and regulated tournament platform for freelance illustrators. This lifeline grant will help retain their status as a global benchmark for excellence in live illustration.

"Culture is an essential part of life across the country, helping to support people's wellbeing through creativity and self-expression, bringing communities together, and fuelling our world class creative industries.



