Joyce Richardson, who struggles to stand up, has been challenging herself to complete 100 stand-ups before her 100th birthday and raise as much money as possible for Herriot Hospice Homecare. On Tuesday 2nd June on her 100th birthday, she exceeded her target of 100 stand ups, using her incredible spirit and perseverance to not only achieve her target but surpass it too.

Captain Sir Tom Moore has led well wishes for Joyce Richardson, fellow inspirational Yorkshire centenarian as she celebrated both her 100th birthday and completing her amazing challenge.

Joyce Richardson, who served in the Women's Land Army during World War Two, nearly lost the use of her legs after developing sepsis last year.

The great-great grandmother is fundraising to thank the charity for the wonderful support her family received. The total raised by Joyce so far, is over £21,000.

He joins thousands of people from the Yorkshire, the UK and around the world who have wished Joyce a Happy Birthday.
