

Juvenile Arthritis Research launches children's art competition

Juvenile Arthritis Research need some new *Thank You* cards, which they send to businesses and organisations that have supported their work, and are calling on children and young people to help!

They are hosting a competition to design their new Thank You cards, with two amazing judges to help them pick the best designs from each of the three age categories, and some great prizes to be won!

The competition is open to anyone aged 3-15 years, and entrants are encouraged to simply draw or paint their design on a plain piece of A4 paper. There will be three winners – one from each age category - and at least one of the winning three designs to be printed as cards.

The age categories are:

- Age 3-6 years
- Age 7-10 years
- Age 11-15 years

A whopping 30 runners-up will also be randomly drawn from all entries, and each will win one book from the prize collection!

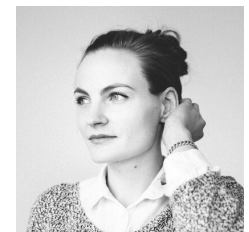

This causes inflammation in their joints, leading to pain, discomfort and loss of mobility. Without effective treatment, it can lead to permanent joint damage.
