The Katy Holmes Trust is a Preston charity set up in January 2012 by David and Paula Holmes following the loss of their 10 year old daughter Katy after a heartbreaking 3 month battle with an aggressive brain tumour. In their quest for answers Katy's parents discovered that brain tumours are the biggest cancer killers of children in the UK and adults under 40. They also learned that less than 1% of the national cancer research spending goes towards brain tumour research. The cause of brain tumours is unknown and there is no known cure either so the Katy Holmes Trust raises money to fund paediatric brain tumour research and raises awareness of this cruel disease.

Paula Holmes had this to say: "When we lost Katy our hearts were broken beyond repair and we had no idea how we were going to cope. The people of the North West heard our story and came on board to help us as we launched our charity. They took us and our 2 other children into their hearts and thanks to their support the charity has grown bigger each year. The charity funds research which isn't something anybody can physically see until lives are saved in years to come. We wanted to do something to give back to the community that supported us and celebrate others who have overcome adversities of some kind, this way everyone can see how else their contributions are helping"

David Holmes said: "This event promises to be very special indeed but in order for that to happen the Katy Holmes Trust is reaching out to businesses from across the North West to get involved!
