On Sunday, September 20, 2026, we come together to mark World ALL Day, a global campaign aiming to raise awareness of acute lymphoblastic leukemia (ALL) and amplify the voices of patients, as well as the families, caregivers, and communities who support them. The World ALL Day 2026 campaign aims to:

- Help people feel supported, by sharing real experiences of living with ALL, so patients and caregivers can relate to others who truly understand their journey.
- Make it easier for those affected by ALL to find and join supportive communities, including patient groups and WhatsApp chats, where they can ask questions and learn from shared experiences.
- Bring the ALL community together, by encouraging people to share and listen to others, building a sense of belonging and ensuring patients and caregivers are not facing ALL on their own.

For World ALL Day 2026, we're inviting our community to take part in a simple but meaningful campaign: "Together through ALL".
