Know AML is the first global education and awareness initiative that provides patients and caregivers with the information, resources, and support they need to deal with acute myeloid leukemia (AML)—a rare aggressive cancer of the blood and bone marrow which is the most common form of acute leukemia in adults. Know AML formalized AML World Awareness Day on April 21, 2017.

On **April 21**, **2022**, we will continue to campaign, together with our global network and community, to increase understanding of AML and bring attention to the resources available.
