

LEGAL EAGLES TAKE ON MOUNT SNOWDON

A team from Temporis Legal Recruitment scaled the great heights of Snowdon in support of a national youth cancer charity.

The Temporis team recently completed the challenge to climb Mount Snowdon in aid of the Laura Crane Youth Cancer Trust. The team of 6 completed the climb and have raised over £1,000 for the Huddersfield based charity.

Snowdon is the highest mountain in Wales, at an elevation of 1,085 metres above sea level, and the highest point in the British Isles outside the Scottish Highlands. Tackling Snowdon was the first challenge for the team at Temporis and they are now setting their sights on the National Three Peaks as they are truly determined to continue their fight against cancer in young people.

Gemma Iveson said of the Mount Snowdon challenge: "None of us have ever completed anything like this before and it was tougher than we expected, but we were so proud of everyone in the team for taking up the challenge and for their success – we are definitely ready for the next big challenge!"
