

LOCAL BUSINESSES URGED TO REDUCE RUBBISH FOR 'ZERO WASTE WEEK'

Local companies are being encouraged to go waste-free for Investors in the Environment's (iIE) Zero Waste Week, which will be running across Yorkshire from 18th November.

Zero Waste Week will see a series of events designed especially to help businesses reduce waste and save money, as well as do their bit for the environment. The events will also provide valuable networking opportunities with like-minded businesses.

WRAP, the company set up to improve recycling, states that "around 600 million tonnes of products and materials enter the UK economy each year with only 115 million tonnes of this getting recycled." This figure can be significantly increased just by improving waste processes.

Zero Waste Week is sponsored by Biffa, who has just signed up to become Investors in the Environment's 50th member in the Yorkshire and Humber region.
