Everyone was so welcoming and friendly - a real boost just before Christmas. I was also sitting next to another client and she too had a great time! Thanks for all your hard work and efforts."

The party was generously funded by house builder <u>Fairview</u>, which also supported Age UK Camden's recent Christmas bazaar – one of its biggest fundraising events to date. <u>Simkins LLP</u> and <u>Menzies LLP</u> also supported the event and mince pies were provided by <u>Greggs</u> in Camden.

Suzy Barber, Fundraising Officer at Age UK Camden, said: "This time of year can be difficult for many, but especially older people whose families may have moved away, or whom they've lost touch with, or who can't get out as much as they used to.
