Although live congresses continue to be on hold, we have been excited to be able to report on new and ground-breaking data, which continues to be presented very successfully at international meetings in a virtual format.

During August and September, the Lymphoma Hub was pleased to provide live coverage of two virtual congresses, the 46th Annual Meeting of the European Society for Blood and Marrow Transplantation (EBMT) and the Eighth Annual Meeting of the Society of Hematologic Oncology (SOHO). During these congresses, the Lymphoma Hub produced video interviews with key experts, provided social media coverage, and generated written summaries from key sessions.
