

Manchester powers up 'hyper-city' status as first buildings go live with gigabit services

Greater Manchester residents are celebrating the arrival of gigabit broadband, the first installation of its kind to be made available in the region.

[Hyperoptic](#), the UK's leading provider of Fibre-to-the-Home broadband, has switched on services in two developments in Greater Manchester. The 'switch-on', in Sovereign Point and Imperial Point (Salford Quays) provides residents with access to the UK's fastest available consumer internet speeds of 1 Gigabit-per-second (1,000Mbps).
