The exterior façade is rendered with **weber.pral M** in Cream and provides a durable, decorative and weather resistant finish well suited to this exposed location and in keeping with the local vernacular.

Applicator J J Runcie Plasterers Limited applied the BBA (British Board of Agrément) approved **weber.pral M** monocouche render. This high specification product offers the multiple benefits of through-coloured One-coat Technology which is recognised for its ease and speed of application. By reducing the drying time associated with a traditional multi-coat system by as much as 50%, significant on-site cost savings can be made which contributes to project efficiencies and earlier completion.
