Recent surveys indicate that only one in ten people plan to attend a festival this year, further highlighting the challenging environment (Stat from AIF). "We've expanded to two sites this year. Both events are selling well, and that's a testament to the vision of this event, our fantastic team and loyal customers."

From high-adrenaline thrills like abseiling and water activities to attending inspiring talks from world-renowned adventurers Bear Grylls OBE and Sir Ranulph Fiennes.
