After serving in the military for over 30 years he decided to hang up his uniform so he could settle down into civilian life, and thanks to Wincanton his journey to doing that was made simpler.

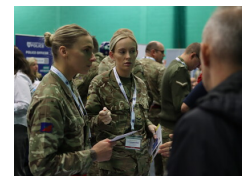
Below we have a short interview with Rob where he explains the reason's he decided now was the time for him to make the leap and start his resettlement.
