NICE - Centre for Movement Disorders is a small charity based in Birmingham. NICE transforms the lives of local people with neurological conditions through **Conductive Education**; an educational, can-do approach to disability.

The **NICE Days of Christmas** is an appeal in support of those families who are yet to receive our services. Our goal is to raise **£5,000** from our appeal, helping children and adults to attend free introductory sessions with us.

This **£5,000** would give **four adults** affected by a range of neurological conditions the chance to each attend 12 free conductive education sessions at NICE. These sessions provide opportunities to trial positive, can-do techniques to counter the difficulties neurological conditions present. These sessions are essential for adults to understand more about how their abilities prevail in the face of functional changes to their balance and speech.

Reaching **£5,000** can also give at least **two children** facing neurological conditions 12 free conductive education sessions in **our parent and child group**. They are critical for babies and toddlers to receive early intervention, exploring the world around them with the focus on their unique potential.
