The National Extension College (NEC) has some excellent GCSE and IGCSE results today. 74% have received grades A*-C, compared to 68% nationally. Despite the drop in science grades nationally, 73% NEC students have achieved grades A^* - C against a national average of 58%.

NEC learners might be active forces personnel on rotation in Afghanistan or at sea, or working mothers who are retraining for a career in teaching or midwifery, we really do have learners from all walks of life.
