2. Portlebay has a whole range of delicious popcorn flavours made with specially developed natural seasonings such as their most popular Crispy Bacon & Maple Syrup. Their classic Sweet & Salty Kracklecorn is made by adding raw cane sugar into the pot just as the grains are popping to give a crunchy texture, followed by a sprinkling of sea salt to give that contrast in flavours.
