cause physical injury, there are calls for companies to introduce something similar for mental health.

Statistics from the seminar included "every 90 minutes, someone in the UK takes their own life", "In the UK in 2014 there were 6,122 recorded deaths by suicide, of which 76% were men." and "suicide is the biggest cause of death for men under 50 with the highest suicide rate being among males aged 45-59".

Lyndon Wood, CEO and founder of constructaquote.com said: "These statistics are extremely alarming but as a business that has always cared about people, the fact we're bringing these issues to light and the construction industry is taking them seriously is a positive step in the right direction."
