Sweetman urged businesses to be the first to take up this new and improved approach to upskilling:

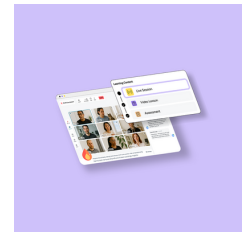
