

Ramadan dua eCards launched by Hope Spring

Water poverty alleviation charity, Hope Spring launched thirty sets of [charity eCards](#), called Ramadan dua eCards today, the 28th of April. The eCards targeted at Muslims, represent the thirty days of the holy month of Ramadan. Each eCard contains prayers and supplication for each day of Ramadan.

The [Ramadan dua eCards](#) was devised and created for Hope Spring eCard by volunteer fundraiser [Abdulwasiu Abdulraheem](#), a practising Muslim.
