We are looking for information on anyone that the public may suspect of being involved in dog fighting, including locations used for fighting dogs, the rearing, breeding and sale of fighting dogs, and any other useful information that may assist our investigations"

"We are offering a reward of up to £1,000 for information leading to a conviction of dog fighting. All of the information that is provided to us will be treated in the strictest confidence and any source may wish to remain anonymous."
