London – With their slender bodies painted to look like Yeomen Warders' uniforms, two sexy PETA "Beefeaters" – both vegans – stood outside the Tower of London with signs reading, "Beefeaters: No! Vegans: Yes, Please!" on Tuesday morning, one day before St George's Day, to encourage their fellow citizens to kick their meat-eating habit for their health, the environment, animals and England.

"As St George showed us, humans will go to extremes to save their own lives, but our nation's addiction to the fatty flesh in burgers and bangers is hurting – not helping – England", says sexy 23 year old PETA "Beefeater" Loretta Hope from Redditch. "We are here to let our fellow citizens know that vegans are, on average, 10 to 20 pounds lighter than meat-eaters are – and since they're not contributing to animal suffering, their consciences are lighter, too!"
