Jamie Nicholls, Team GB Snowboarder, couldn't disagree more: "Katie may think skiers have the edge but she's completely wrong, snowboarders have far more style on jumps and rails and when they fall to the floor they don't explode into a million pieces and cry about it like skiers do. Skiers also cut the piste up and trample all over your board in lift lines, not to mention their massively oversized clothing! Snowboarding is just way cooler."
