"CASBA helped me stand up for my right to education" says B, who was able to complete his studies with CASBA's advocacy support.

At CASBA Advocacy's Self-Advocate group "We talk about things that affect our lives" says young self-advocate M.

"Before CASBA I wouldn't talk to anyone, now I want to tell people what is possible with CASBA Advocacy's help" says J.
