The free Pingit app enables users to track every purchase after it's been made, and securely pause or block the payment functionality if the bracelet were to be lost or stolen. Compatible with any UK current account, the bracelets and fobs are a quick, secure and infinitely stylish way to pay for day-to-day expenses.

The Pingit app not only gives shoppers full control over the payment functionality of their Tovi Sorga devices – allowing them to enjoy the control of manual or auto top up and to organise spending between different wearables through separate 'Jars' within the app – it also lets them pay friends and family in over 40 countries fee-free with only a mobile number.
