

SURVEY REVEALS PEOPLE ARE SMOKING MORE DURING COVID-19 LOCK DOWN.

Thursday 23 April, 2020

People are smoking more during lock down. 46% of survey respondents reported that distancing had affected how much they smoked, and 30% reported feeling more stressed. Smokers are at higher risk of suffering serious COVID-19 complications creating an urgent need for smokers to quit.

Ibiza Vape Club report that a limited survey into smoking habits during lock down, has revealed that smokers have dramatically increased the amount they are smoking. Ibiza Vape Club launched a smoking cessation programme - **SWITCH TO QUIT** - that is designed to support smokers who want to quit by switching to vaping (the use of e-cigarettes is fully supported by NHS Smoke Free services). commented during an ITV news broadcast, that those who smoke have more than likely damaged the cells protecting their nose and airways.
